2. Review Cemetery brochures
 - A draft of the 2022 brochure was reviewed and approved for mailing.
3. Review regulations for supplementary burial markers
 - Draft language for a code update was reviewed and discussed.
4. Review regulations for columbariums
 - Draft language for a code update was reviewed and discussed.
5. Review improvements to McDaniel Cemetery
 - The new fence around the McCorkle plot in McDaniel Cemetery was reviewed.
6. Review Cemetery Activity
 - All cemetery activity since January 2021 was provided to the Board for review.
7. Miscellaneous
 - The Board discussed how long to keep the decorations that are removed from graves. Plastic flowers and such will be kept for one year. More substantial decorations will be kept longer at the cemetery maintenance shed.

RECOMMENDATIONS (IF ANY):

1. An Ordinance to update the code recommending up to three (3) supplementary markers be allowed for spaces with multiple cremation burials will be presented to Council as well as allowing small, private columbariums which can hold up to four (4) cremation remains.
